CAMP Respiratory Muscle Training

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This **C**linical **A**pplications **M**entoring **P**rogram provides in-depth training in Respiratory Muscle Training (RMT) through a blended model of on-demand learning and group mentoring calls. Participants will learn about evidence for RMT, applications of RMT across various diagnoses and settings, troubleshooting, and how to develop an RMT program.

## LEARNER OUTCOMES

As a result of this course, participants will be able to:

- Verbalize anatomic / physiologic components of swallowing, cough, & respiration
- Explain the importance of accurate MIP & MEP in RMT treatment planning
- Identify 3 clinical indications for EMT and/or IMT in individuals with dysphagia
- List 2 contraindications for EMT and/or IMT in individuals with dysphagia
- Demonstrate the ability to set appropriate treatment goals
- Describes steps necessary to develop an RMT program in their setting(s)
- Apply critical thinking skills to case studies in various populations

## COURSE COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS
